POSITION SUMMARY:

This position supports the work of the Y, a leading nonprofit committed to strengthening community through youth development, healthy living and social responsibility. The Swim Instructor must demonstrate competency to teach and lead specific skills and activities in the water. In addition, the Swim instructor effectively build community and modify as needed to meet varied health, ability, and cultural needs. Swim instructors must create a safe and positive atmosphere that promotes member safety and engagement in accordance with YMCA policies and procedures.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Instruct and evaluate students participating in swim lessons
- 2. Responsible for the safety of participants in his or her own class
- 3. Begin and end class on time, remain after class to answer participant and/or parent questions
- 4. Maintain cleanliness and organize swim lesson equipment
- 5. Submit completed skill sheets, certificates, and attendance information on time
- 6. Maintains effective relationships with members, participants, and other staff
- 7. Presents a professional appearance and attitude at all times
